



### Our Violence Prevention & Intervention Advocates:

Intervened to prevent future violence and promote healthy relationships with 3,943 individuals.



Intervened and provided emergency safe shelter at our Lewis Houses for 303 individuals fleeing domestic violence. About half were children.



Advocated for 447 victims of sexual assault, including 41 children.



Served 3,064 on an outreach basis; answering calls to the crisisline, following up on police reports, and much more.

Provided domestic and sexual violence awareness education for 4,303 community members.


