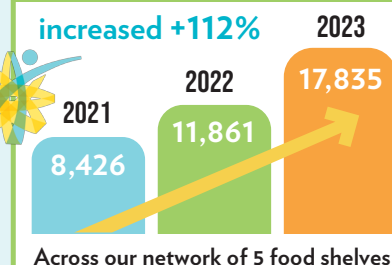
IN 2023, we distributed a total of

Our Violence Prevention & Intervention Advocates:

Intervened to prevent future violence
and promote healthy relationships with
3,943 individuals.

Intervened and provided emergency
safe shelter at our Lewis Houses for
303 individuals fleeing domestic
violence. About half were children.

Advocated for 447 victims of sexual assault,
including 41 children.

Served 3,064 on an outreach basis; answering
calls to the crisisline, following up on police reports, and much more.

Provided domestic and sexual violence awareness education for
4,303 community members.

in 29 schools across
6 school districts
in Dakota County

We helped 1,283
students stay on track
toward high school
graduation, including
41 high school seniors
who graduated in 2023.

84% of students with academic goals improved or
stabilized their performance.

87% of students with attendance goals achieved
their goals toward improved attendance.

84% of families with housing stability goals attained
their goals toward stabilizing their housing.

Our Child Care Aware program for children ages 0-5
expanded to cover Dakota, Scott, and Carver counties.

Our coaches equipped 219 child care providers with the skills
that improved early childhood development for 6,807 children.

Our service area increased by 51%
to include
74 more
child care providers



777 volunteers provided 42,617 hours of meaningful service to support our mission.
